### Policies and Restrictions

- Students may not take continuing education classes.
- Students may only request up to two classes or six credit hours (whichever is greater) per term.
- To use the intercampus enrollment process, **students must remain enrolled for at least one class at their home main campus during the term.** Graduate students in certain programs are exempt (see table at right; see your home campus registrar's office for details).
- The student's home campus will verify the student's eligibility. If all requirements are met, the registrar's office will enroll the student at the host campus.
- Students are enrolled by the home campus registrar's office during the enrollment window that corresponds to their level or classification (e.g., freshman, sophomore, graduate); enrollment is not allowed before or after. This excludes the Anschutz campus, where students will be enrolled on the first day of classes.
- Host campus add and drop deadlines apply; please see the host campus's registrar's office webpage.
- The home campus will assess tuition and fees at the home campus's rates.
- Students will be notified by email when they are enrolled or if their request cannot be fulfilled.
- Services at the host campus, including portal access, will not be available until 72 hours after the student is initially registered. Students must contact the host campus OIT for portal or learning management system issues:
